

EU EMISSIONS TRADING SCHEME



The European Union's Emission Trading Scheme (EU ETS) consists one of the Flexible Mechanisms for the control and reduction of Greenhouse Gases emissions (GHG emissions). Its implementation is mandatory to all the EU Member States since 2005. Every installation or aviation company participating in the EU ETS has the obligation to monitor its GHG emissions, to report them in an Annual Report and to return to the competent authority (Registry) a sum of allowances equal to its emissions. A sum of emission allowances is allocated free of charge by each Member State to the facilities of some activity sectors at the beginning of each calendar year (starting 2013 and then, electricity producers don't receive free allocation), in accordance to the allocation plans that are structured at the start of each Trading Period. Each allowance amounts to one tonne of equivalent CO₂.

The EU ETS converts Greenhouse Gases into a market commodity. Emission allowances are tradable among installations, and via carbon exchanges. Concurrently, a variety of different types of allowances and carbon products derivatives has been put into circulation. Every company that takes action quickly and determinedly, monitors its GHG emissions, stays informed and manages properly its allowances, not only will it minimize the cost of participation in the EU ETS, but in many cases it can have a considerable economic benefit as well.

Calculation and Report of Greenhouse Gases Emissions

Every system is unique and adapted to the company for which it is developed. It can be applied independently or as a part of an applied Management & Environmental Quality System (ISO 9001, ISO 14001). In addition, IPPC can be assigned to operate the system in a continuous basis, or to control the system through external inspections.

Emission Allowances Trade

IPPC can provide access to national and international carbon markets to trade EUA, EUAA, CER and ERU. IPPC offers reliable, secure and quick spot transactions.
